

# MENTORS NEEDED



## YRG MENTOR PROGRAM - VALLEJO, CA

The YRG Mentor program is designed to match high school students with culturally relevant mentors for a minimum commitment of 12 weeks. Mentors will meet weekly with the mentee in a safe and neutral setting, such as the library, coffee shop, etc. The location must be easily accessible for the mentee.

Referrals will come from the School District for youth whose behavior could lead them to have contact with the justice system if not otherwise interrupted.

The mentoring program will focus on ensuring young people stay in education, aren't involved in gang culture or anti-social behavior, and work hard to achieve the goals they set.


All Mentors will need to be Live Scanned. All mentor trainings, both initial and future skill based training, will be provided at no cost to the mentor and is a mandatory part of the program.


The YRG Mentor Program is based on the XL-Mentoring model. The XL-Mentor Program is about hope. It is about accompanying young people who are struggling and helping them to see alternatives to what can sometimes seem a hopeless situation.

All youth deserve someone who they can turn to for help. Become that someone. Become a YRG Mentor!

NOTE: Prior involvement with the justice system should not deter anyone from applying. A waiver can be requested based on individual circumstances.
